

Career Life Connections (CLC 12B)

THE BASICS

INTRODUCTION

Career Life Connections 12 is a requirement for all BC secondary students who are graduating as of June 2020.

Goal

Career Life Connections is intended to prepare students by having a transition plan to life after secondary school.

In order to meet this goal, CLC encourages you to:

- take ownership of your own goals and learning
- examine and demonstrate connections between your learning, your future, your life
- create a plan for your growth and development as skilled, healthy, knowledgeable, participating citizen
- Understanding the need for a balanced life
- exhibit attributes of a BC graduate

With support and guidance from family, teachers, and counsellors, students are responsible for planning and preparing education, career, and life goals through Career Life Connections

Components

Career Life Connections consists of three (3) components and they are:

- **Personal Health**
 - Personal Healthy Living Plan
- **Community Connections**
 - At least 30 hours of work experience and/or community service
 - Demonstration of your experience and skill set, and how this benefits both you and the community
- **Career and Life**
 - Comprehensive plan that indicates you are prepared to transition from secondary school
 - Present selected components of your transition plan with your **Capstone Presentation in January 2020**.

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Implementation

- Many other courses and extra-curricular activities offered at GW Graham are designed to meet one or more of the Prescribed Learning Outcomes (PLO's) for Career Life Connections. Therefore, in-school and/or out-of-school activities and learning experiences should provide ample opportunities for you to meet this graduation requirement.
- Students are provided with time and opportunity to work on their Career Life Connections during their daily Career Ed Class (formerly Advisory)
- **MyBlueprint** is the online platform that students utilize to document the evidence of their learning. Students (and parents) have access to this 24/7.
- Grade 12 students are expected to book a meeting with their counsellor in Oct to ensure that they are set up to meet Graduation Requirements, Create their Student Transcripts accounts, select the PSI's they wish to send transcripts to. Additionally, we book their Final Capstone Interview in January 2020. Sign up sheets are on the counsellors' doors.
