Tuesday, September 8th and Wednesday, September 9th – NO CLASSES

- ➢ No Classes.
- > Staff will be going over Health and Safety protocols and new school procedures.
- Staff will also have department meetings to go over final plans for implementing our new Octet Schedule (one class all day for approximately five weeks).

Preparing for the Opening Day – Thursday, September 10th - Morning Class Only

- Students should access their timetable on MyEd BC. Review the MyEd BC Student. Manual on our school <u>website</u> for the following information:
 - How to Log-in
 - Checking Your Class Schedule
 - Checking Your Grades (not necessary for opening day)
- Email your <u>school counsellor</u> if you have any course change requests. Graduation requirement and post-secondary planning are the main priorities for accommodating course change requests.
- Make sure you know the course and room number for your Octet 1 class. Students are unable to change a course once it starts.
- Check the <u>school map</u> to see the section where your course is located.
- Check the <u>school map</u> to see the exterior doors that you will use for your Octet 1 course.
- View the <u>student videos</u> on our website to see more information about your school section.

Mandatory Daily Health Screening

- > To stop the spread of COVID-19, daily health screening is mandatory for students and staff.
- > Parents are responsible for assessing their child before they come to school.
- Parents and students are asked to utilize this <u>screening check-list</u> prior to coming to school each day.
- Students and staff who are unwell must not enter the school.
- If a student falls ill while at school or is showing any COVID signs or symptoms, they will be required to go home.
- If there is an instance of a confirmed case at school, the school and district will take guidance from Fraser Health on how to proceed.

- Students should know their room number and exterior door for their Octet 1 class. If not, there will be help stations located at the main entrance and the bus loop to assist students.
- > Welcoming Staff Teams will be at all exterior doors.

- Students should sanitize or wash their hands upon entering the school or their portable
