2018 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students require 80 credits *minimum* to graduate

Included within these credit requirements are the following **MUST** have:

- A minimum of **16 credits at the grade 12 level**: specifically, **4 credits for Language Arts 12**, and the other **12 credits from Electives**
- A minimum of **4 credits from either a Fine Arts or Applied Skills** course at any grades 10, 11, or 12 level
- A minimum of **4 credits must have an Indigenous focus** (at GW Graham we meet this requirement with *English First Peoples* in Grade 11)
- A minimum of **8 credits from CLE 10** (Career Life Education) **and** **CLC 12A & 12B** (Career Life Connections + CAPstone): course work commences in grade 9. CLE and CLC are intended to aid students in their transition to life after secondary school as outlined in their Portfolio – which is presented in their grade 12 CAPstone Interview, held during January Assessment week. Students utilize the **myblueprint** web-based program to house the portfolio and evidence of learning. This requirement also includes 30 hours of paid or volunteer work in their Grade 12 year. CLE/CLC attendance is mandatory.
