REVISED ATHLETIC FEES

At Graham Athletics, every student-athlete who puts on the Navy and White is part of something bigger than a single season — a program built on effort, opportunity, and pride. We work hard year-round to generate significant fundraised revenue so that student-athlete fees stay as low as possible each season; even so, athletic fees remain essential to ensuring we can continue to do what we do.

Effective September 2026, and to keep supporting our teams at the level our student-athletes deserve, Graham Athletics will move to a revised athletic fee structure for the 2026–27 school year.

This update reflects rising costs across transportation, equipment, uniforms, and facility rentals. Every sport in our program is valued equally, and every student-athlete continues to receive the same depth of opportunity — but the true cost of running each program varies with league requirements, season length, competition schedule, and facility needs. The categories below reflect those real differences as fairly and transparently as possible.

Golf* — Student-athletes are responsible for additional green fees incurred during exhibition competitions throughout the season.

Basketball & Volleyball** — The base athletic fee does not include additional costs associated with overnight travel and tournament participation.

- Athletic fees cover participation costs for the respective sport season only.
- Fees listed above do not include optional team apparel or spirit wear that may be offered during the season.
- Any additional costs related to special events, extended travel, or optional team activities will be communicated directly by coaches and team staff as needed.
